### **Poster sessions of noodle exhibition – Pair project**

#### **Description:**

Many varieties of noodles exist in China, Italy, and many other countries. Noodles vary according to their shapes, manners of preparation, geographic regions, ingredients, etc. They also bear diverse symbolic meanings in different cultures.

This pair project gives you an opportunity to showcase your favorite type of noodle through a poster presentation. On your poster, you should include (but are not limited to) the following information.

- Name of the noodle (written in Chinese/Italian and English).
- Your names.
- Basic information about the noodle. Up to 300 words. Use images to enhance your narrative.
- A photo of the noodle before it is cooked. Better yet – tape the actual noodle to the board.
- A simple recipe for a noodle dish using the noodle.
- A photo of the cooked noodle dish.
- Description of its cultural significance/symbolic meanings and conclusion. Up to 300 words.
- References

#### **Requirements and Grading Rubrics:**

- Focused and concise– Information is presented logically and concisely. 30%
- Compelling graphics – you let the images and graphs tell the story. You use words sparingly. 30%
- Organized – keep the sequence of information well-ordered and make sure the order is obvious to the audience. 20%
- Personality and creativity – Your poster shows your interests and talents. It helps the instructors and your peers get to know who you are. 20%

#### **Extra Points:**

You can earn up to five extra points if you cook the noodle and bring the dish to share with the class.
